Projects have a wide variety of skill level needed, so Ocoee Outreach is a great place for groups who have little to no experience but also for groups who are very skilled.

Overview of Ocoee Outreach: Who we are.

Vision: the what.

We extend the grace of Christ through providing access to the Gospel and safe housing by revitalizing and investing in our community.

Mission: the how.

Empower our volunteers to bring hope through evangelism and restore dignity in the lives of homeowners through home repair and building intentional relationships.

<u>Compelled</u> by what Christ has done for us (2 Corinthians 5:14-21), Ocoee Outreach holds to these CORE VALUES:

- <u>Uphold</u> the dignity of ALL people as image bearers of God (John 15:12; Genesis 1:27; Psalm 139:13)
 - Share the Gospel with intentionality (Matthew 28:19; Acts 1:8; Romans 10:12-15)
 - Serve as Christ modeled for us (John 13:15-17)
- Connect the local church to the community (Romans 12:9-21)
- Complete quality, God-honoring work on all sites (Romans 11:36; 1 Corinthians 10:31)

We offer a complete missions experience that meets our volunteers and groups where they are while challenging them to go deeper in their walk with Christ! Ocoee Outreach is a great opportunity for volunteers to see a great need and then meet that need by being the hands and feet of Jesus.

Here in Cleveland, TN and the surrounding areas, **the need** is very real. While we have extreme wealth in certain areas, the southeast section of Cleveland is one of the most impoverished areas in the COUNTRY.

- Only 56% have a high school education
- 96% of children receive free/reduced meals in public schools
 - Only 1 in 4 families have a male head of household
- Average yearly family income of home repair applicants is \$15,000
- Average household income is \$20,000 below the national average



How Ocoee Outreach meets the need:

- Home Repair- painting exterior of homes, light carpentry, roofing homes, building wheelchair ramps
- Backyard Bible Clubs/Community wide VBS at local Boys & Girls Clubs or apartment complexes
 - Sports Camps
 - Evangelistic Block Parties

What your week with us will look like:

Sunday

3:00-5:00pm- Register/Check in at your place of lodging 6:00-8:00pm- Kickoff service at a local church & orientation with Ocoee staff

*Dinner is on your own Sunday evening- we suggest eating an early dinner before worship! *Upon arrival/check in, please be prepared to pay group balance & have all hard copy forms ready to turn in to the Ocoee Outreach staff.

Monday-Thursday

7:45am- arrive at ministry job sites
8:45am- VBS teams arrive to sites (exact times will vary based on the site!)
11:30am- Lunch & Bible study led by Ocoee Outreach staff on site
12:30pm- Back to work
2:30-3:00pm- clean up construction sites & head back to lodging
5:30pm- dinner at a local church (*Thursday night is 6pm!)
6:30pm-?- ministry/group nights

*Thursday night is our closing celebration at 6pm! ALL volunteer teams will be together for a cookout and a night of fellowship & celebration of all that God has done!

*Monday & Tuesday nights can be used to host a block party in a neighborhood, visit local nursing homes (dependent on covid restrictions) or any other community outreach event you'd like to do!

*Wednesday night you can have group time or join in with a local church if you'd like! Please just make sure Callie knows your preference so she can make arrangements for you!

General Info:

- \$50 non-refundable deposit per person <u>due 60 days prior</u> to your arrival in Cleveland. (*should a participant drop, we can apply that \$50 to your trip total*)
- Within 30 days of your arrival, deposits for those who drop WILL
 NOT be refunded nor applied to your trip total.
- Group balance is due upon your arrival/check in
- Breakfasts are the group's responsibility (provided if staying at the hotel!)
- Sunday evening & Friday meals are the responsibility of the group

• **EVERY** mission team volunteer age 18 and up is **REQUIRED** to have a background check within 4 years of their participation. If your church already does background checks for volunteers, we will just need a copy/verification on each participant. If you need Ocoee Outreach to run the background check for your volunteers, the cost is \$15 per person.

Summer 2024 Priority List

- 1. Fill out & return the group preliminary information form- BOTH SIDES! (even though these won't be your final numbers, PLEASE fill it out fully with your best estimates)
- 2. Fill out & return the Church Covenant form with team leader & pastor signatures
- 3. Recruit mission team members!
- 4. Prepare the team- discipleship, sharing the Gospel and their own story, ministry skills development, team building, etc. We will provide you with some materials to cover with your team closer to the summer arriving that will assist in this process!
- 5. Raise money as needed
- 6. Team leader or representative MUST participate in the pre-project meetings (a Friday evening- Saturday in late April... exact dates TBD)
 - This meeting will give you an opportunity to come to Cleveland and meet the staff and hopefully see the project your group will take on during your week.
 - If coming to Cleveland isn't a possibility for you, we will arrange a virtual meeting with you!
- 7. Turn in \$50/person, forms, group roster, t-shirt sizes to CrossNet/Ocoee Outreach office 60 days prior to arrival.
- 8. Have a send off/commissioning for your group
- 9. EXPECT God to do great things in and through your group while serving with Ocoee Outreach!
