Ocoee Outreach is a non-profit home repair ministry in the Cleveland/Bradley County area..

Who We Are.

Vision: the what.

We extend the grace of Christ through providing access to the Gospel and safe housing by revitalizing and investing in our community.

Mission: the how.

Empower our volunteers to bring hope through evangelism and restore dignity in the lives of homeowners through home repair and building intentional relationships.

The Why.

Two extremes: while we are home to one of the wealthiest areas per capita in Tennessee, we are also home to one of the nation's most impoverished areas... Southeast Cleveland.

- Average income for 4 is just over \$13,000.
- 97% of childrens on free/reduced lunch plans
- 56% of adults with no high school education











2026 Summer Missionary Job Description

Our ministry is designed to help low income families repair their homes completely free of charge. Many of these homes are owned by senior adults, the disabled, and the marginalized. We utilize this avenue of home repair to develop authentic relationships and in order to have an opportunity to share the Gospel and hope of Jesus Christ! We serve people simply because of the example Jesus set for us as His followers. Our main goal is to come alongside people, not just complete projects.

We want to see the following happen on every work site:

- -Give homeowners access to the Gospel & Safe housing
 - -Empower homeowners to take pride in their homes
- -Empower our volunteers to bring hope to homeowners
- -Empower our volunteers to see how their experience with Ocoee Outreach can be duplicated in their own community

As a summer missionary, you lead by example-through your work ethic, words, attitude, and spiritual preparation.



2026 Summer Missionary Requirements

- in a growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- An active part of a local church
- High level of integrity
- Ability to lead & encourage volunteers of ALL ages
- Flexible & Adaptable
- All around team player
- Ability to pass a background check

Terms of Service/Employment

- 9-10 weeks of service beginning last week of May & ending first week of August
- One week of REQUIRED training prior to the summer- May 26-May 28, 2026
- Weekly pay of \$200
- Also provided for staff: Monday-Thursday meals; gasoline reimbursement; housing arrangements for non-local staff members at a host home/mission home setting



2026 Summer Missionary Responsibilities

- · Arrive to all ministry sites & meetings on time
- Relate positively to Ocoee Outreach staff, mission teams, homeowners, neighbors, runners
- Assist in planning/leading in weekly kickoff service on Sunday nights. You will be responsible to lead your team through a time of orientation.
- Assist in planning/leading the wrap up service on Thursday nights (awards, worship, prayer, etc)
- Lead volunteers/teams in the spiritual aspects of the week which include, but are not limited to, prayer walking, face to face Gospel conversations, sharing your Jesus story, etc
- Lead the daily Bible studies on your site during lunch
- Develop ministry relationships with community partners & vendors/suppliers
- Maintain/clean water coolers & first aid kits for your site
- Act as a resource for your assigned team
- Act as a liaison between the volunteer team & homeowner
- Communicate with Construction Supervisor about any construction needs that arise
- Act as a "runner" for materials, supplies, etc if necessary
- Greet lunch runners & set up on site daily
- · Keep a record of expenses/receipts for your site
- Complete a follow up interview with homeowner & have evaluation form filled out-RETURN IT TO CALLIE!
- Assist with "chores"- office housekeeping, equipment cleaning, inventory, etc as assigned
- Assist/participate in as many ministry activities as possible with your team
- Eat dinners with your team whenever possible



2026 Summer Missionary Evaluation & Review

- Summer staff will be required to attend weekly staff "debriefs" on Thursday nights after the weekly wrap up service- these typically happen at someone's home & include desserts!
- Individual checkin's will happen with Callie in the mid summer

A Day in the life... what to expect.

"What will my day to day schedule look like?" Glad you asked! Here's a typical week.

Sunday- First day of our work week!

4:00-6:00pm- greeting incoming groups; set up at host church

6:00-8:00pm- kickoff worship; orientation

8:00-?- dinner as a staff (not required!)

Monday-Wednesday

7:00am-3:00pm- work on site (includes taking before pics, prayer walking, Bible studies, etc)

5:30-6:30pm- dinner at a local church with groups

6:30-?- if your group is hosting a block party, going to the Blue Hole, etc go with them if available!

Thursday

7:00am-3:00pm-work on site- FULL clean up, homeowner evaluation forms, group pics, after pics)

5:00-7:30pm- Weekly Wrap Up Service (includes

dinner, awards, stories from the week)

8:30-9:30ish-Staff Debrief- pray, vent, cry, laugh as a staff!
